ADVANCE CARE PLANNING INITIATIVE - APPLY NOW!

MOQC is now accepting applications for our Advance Care Planning Collaborative! Advance Care Planning (ACP) is a dynamic process that includes a range of elements that may vary depending on individual patient and family needs. At a minimum, ACP includes: clarifying patients' understanding of their illness and treatment options; understanding patients' values, beliefs, and goals of care; identifying patients' wishes; and identifying a substitute decision maker.

MOQC is sponsoring a learning collaborative to:

- 1. Assist the oncologist and the care team in engaging the patient in a discussion of goals, preferences, and priorities for care
- 2. Achieve measurable improvements in advance care planning through the development and implementation of common evidence-based clinical practice guidelines
- 3. Recommend resources and interventions to address advance care planning



TOBACCO CESSATION - MOQC WILL COME TO YOU TO HELP

MOQC, in partnership with the Michigan Cancer Consortium, has dramatically improved tobacco cessation referrals in Michigan with over 700 referrals made to the Quitline from the 18 oncology pilot sites in 8 months! This program

provides free nicotine replacement therapy (NRT) and counseling services to oncology patients. The Quitline referral process takes less than 3 minutes per patient for practice staff to complete.

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NEW FERTILITY RESOURCES AVAILABLE

During the June 2013 Biannual meeting participants did a root cause analysis that identified barriers about the low rate of discussions with oncology patients of childbearing years on chemotherapy infertility risks and/or referral to fertility specialists. Some of the barriers identified were the lack of knowledge, resources, and time. As a result, MOQC has put together a folder of national resources on fertility preservation for both patients and providers.

The patient resources focus on the types of cancer treatment that reduce a patient's fertility, ways to preserve fertility prior to treatment, and questions for men and women to ask their oncologist. The provider resources included the ASCO recommendations for fertility preservation options and discussions, two links to ASCO University videos, male and female fertility preservation options, a list of national resources, and a MOQC roadmap for implementation of the discussions into practice.
