All materials are available to download for free from the MOQC website in Adobe Acrobat PDF format.

- i. Go to <https://moqc.org/>
- ii. Under Resources, click on the 'Hospice Enrollment' tile. Scroll down to 'Patient- and Caregiver-Directed Educational Materials'
- iii. Click on the material you wish to download.
- iv. On the back panel of each material is a swappable logo. To edit: click 'Enable All Features' at the top right of the document.
- v. Click on the logo. Under 'Select Image' click 'Browse' and locate the image that you wish to insert on the material (e.g. your institution's logo). Click 'Ok' and save the document. It is now ready to print.
