

MOQC Excellence in Quality Certification (MEQC)



What is MEQC?

MEQC offers an opportunity to for medical and gynecologic oncology practices to be recognized for their efforts in advancing high-quality care to their patients. MEQC works with collaborative teams including physicians, nurses, medical assistants, abstractors, and patients and caregivers with the purpose of enhancing focus on the value-driven, patient-centered care.

Required Elements for Certification

- Collect 2 rounds of data during the year in which certification is pursued, including a minimum of 10 charts per measure per round*
- Meet specified measure targets
- For medical oncology practices, 1 physician and 1 practice administrator must attend 1 of 2 biannual meetings (January and June) AND the fall regional meeting. For gynecologic oncology practices, a total of 100 engagement points in 2026 is needed to meet attendance requirements.
- Complete a site visit every 2 years for the first 2 visits and every 3 years after that*
- Create a Closing the Gap Action Plan
