Job Summary

MOQC is a Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan-funded Collaborative Quality Initiative (CQI) whose purpose is to support oncology teams in improving the quality and value of cancer care. Our core values are trust, integrity, collaboration, compassion, and a growth mindset. Our team uses data from oncology practices across the state of Michigan to develop and inform quality improvement projects. MOQC centers the voice of patients and caregivers in all the work that we do.

The Associate Program Director will be jointly responsible, in partnership with the Program Director, for setting the vision for the work of MOQC and for leading initiatives to improve the quality of clinical oncology patient care across the state of Michigan. This includes leading the team through planning, design, development, implementation, maintenance, and evaluation of data-informed initiatives. The Associate Program Director will independently liaise with physician champions and assist with root cause analysis and problem-solving in responding to any needs the practices communicate.

The Associate Program Director will participate in planning and facilitating MOQC's consortium-wide biannual meetings and will be involved with planning and facilitation of regional meetings in the spring and fall of each year. These meetings and occasional visits to practices throughout the state will require travel.

This position will allow the candidate to function independently and in collaboration with an outstanding team of change makers, to be innovative and creative, to work with and to contribute to the national and international conversation about quality of care, including equity in care and the value of care. The Associate Program Director will work with a committed group of patients and caregiver leaders.

Responsibilities

- Co-lead, with the Program Director, all aspects of the program to assure ongoing progress.
- Foster collaborative relationships across the consortium.
- Conduct collaborative-wide meetings.
- Facilitate the design and implementation of collaborative-wide quality improvement efforts.
- Work collaboratively with clinical champions at participating hospitals to identify and implement best practices.
- Serve as a point of contact for medical questions or concerns regarding the CQI.
- Represent MOQC at national and state-wide forums on quality and safety both through attendance and presentations.
- Provide guidance for MOQC publications in peer-reviewed journals.
- Develop and implement quality measures and targets.

- Chair committees/task forces as needed.
- Develop opportunities for collaboration with other CQIs.
- Participate in meetings with the sponsor and contribute to deliverables, including MOQC's Statement of Work and budget planning.

- 5 years of experience treating oncology patients
- Current employment at an organization that provides clinical care
- A commitment to the core values of MOQC
- Demonstrated knowledge of quality improvement methodology
- Demonstrated work experience related to the principles of diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Demonstrated strong analytical skills, group leadership, and facilitation skills
